


### First Quarter Financial Update

In 2023, Atlas had an opportunity to operate at full capacity, being fully staffed with no turnover and an amazing and useful office space. We celebrated 25 mentor-mentee pairings, distributed over 1000 lunches to our community, and hosted a number of events that brought hundreds of neighbors and community members into opportunities for relational connection.

We have been so incredibly blessed by our many partners both in Lincoln and beyond. Through the first quarter of 2024, we have nearly 50% of our annual budget raised through pledges and raised funds.
